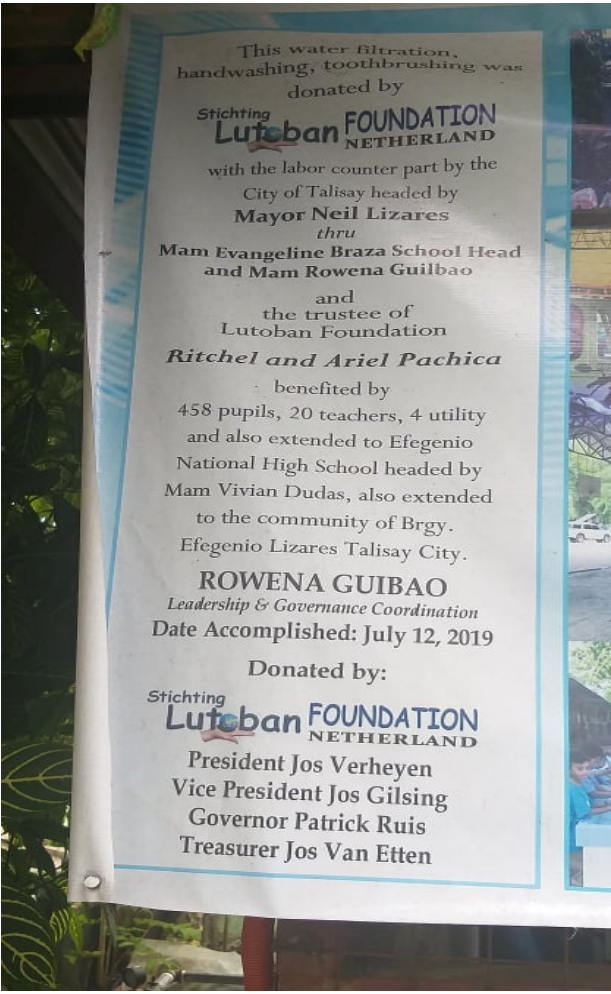
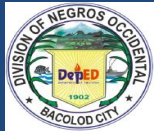


## Best Practices in the Division include:

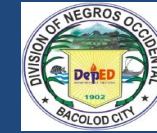


- The use of rainwater catchment for washing

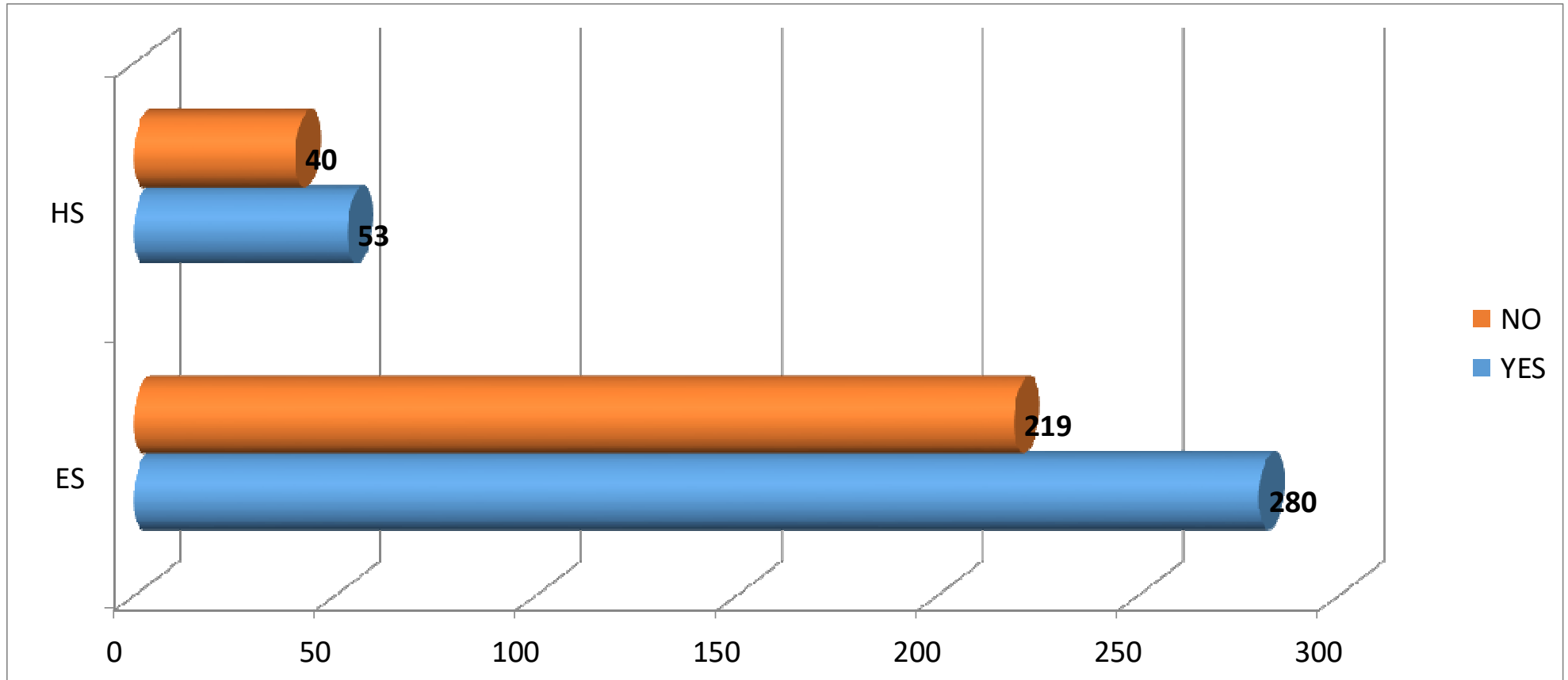
Most Elementary and Secondary Schools were able to provide safe drinking water for their pupils and students.

# **Issues and Concern:**

- 1. Not all schools have potable and reliable water supply.**
- 2. All schools have wash facilities but only 72.55% of ESs and 74.19% of HSs with Access to water.**
- 3. School procurement plan for the construction of adequate drinking facilities for learners and personnel should be included.**
